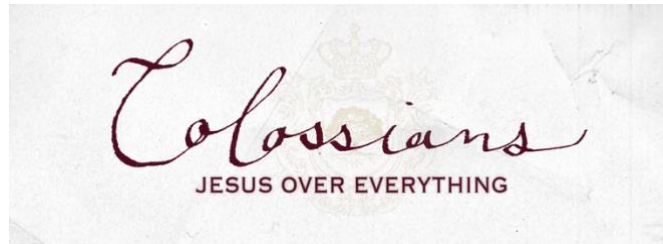


## Colossians 2:6-15



### Conversation Starters:

- **When you hear the phrase, “a full life”, what comes to mind?**
- **What are some things that people commonly chase to feel satisfied or complete?**
- **Have you ever achieved something that you thought would satisfy you - but didn't?**

### Scripture passage: Colossians 2:6-15

#### Observation 1- Live Your Life in Christ

##### Scripture- Colossians 2:6-7

**Questions:** **a)** What does it mean practically to “live your life in Christ”? **b)** Which of these stands out more to you right now: being rooted, built up, strengthened or thankful? Why? **c)** What are some daily habits that help keep you grounded in Christ?

**Statement:** Following Jesus is not just a one time decision, it is a daily ongoing lifestyle. A full life begins when you move beyond receiving Jesus to consistently walking with Him.

#### Observation 2- Realize Jesus Is All You Need.

##### Scripture: Colossians 2:8-10

**Questions:** **a)** What are some modern “add ons” people try to combine with Jesus (success, relationships, money, etc.)? **b)** Why is it so tempting to believe that Jesus isn't enough? **c)** In what area of your life are you most tempted to say “Jesus + something else”?

**Statement:** People often try to add things to Jesus to feel complete, but true fullness is found in Him alone. You don't need more than Jesus, you need more of Jesus.

#### Observation 3- Remember What You Have in Christ.

##### Scripture: Colossians 2:11-15

**Questions:** **a)** Which truth impacts you most: forgiven, alive, free or victorious? Why? **b)** How does remembering what Christ has done change how you live today? **c)** What would your life look like if you fully believed you are already complete in Christ?

**Statement:** Because of Jesus, you have been made alive, forgiven, freed and victorious. When you remember what Jesus has done, you stop striving and start living in His victory.

**Final thoughts:** *Paul's message is clear. Fullness of life is not found in adding more: it is found in going deeper with Jesus. Live in Him daily, trust that He is enough, and remember what He has already done. You don't need more than Jesus, you need more of Jesus.*

- *Ask God to forgive you for times you look to other things to satisfy what only He can fill.*
- *Ask God to help you to walk in Him daily and to remind you of who you are in Christ.*
